- El Chorro Waterfall: Free Visit one of our area's famous waterfalls, one of the seven waterfalls in the world that drops into the ocean. A beautiful walk along deserted beaches & through jungle trails.

- Cabuya Island Cemetery (Isla de Cabuya): ETS / \$ A short drive or ATV ride from Montezuma, this unique island cemetery is accessible only during low tide via a natural rocky path. Used as a burial ground since the 1700s, it offers a serene and reflective atmosphere. Ylang Ylang keeps us updated on the tide schedules to ensure safe passage.
- ATV Ride to Santa Teresa: ETS / \$ Embark on an exhilarating ATV journey from Montezuma to the surf town of Santa Teresa. The route takes you through lush jungles, river crossings, and along scenic coastal paths. Along the way, you can stop at attractions like the Montezuma Waterfalls and the Cabuya Island Cemetery. Ensure you have a map and check tide schedules if planning to visit coastal spots.

Ocean & Beach Activities

- Snorkeling at Tortuga Island: \$ Take a boat tour to Tortuga Island, known for its clear waters and vibrant marine life. While the snorkeling experience can vary due to conditions like jellyfish presence, many find the trip enjoyable for its scenic beauty and beachside lunch.
- Surfing Lessons: \$ The waves around Montezuma are ideal for beginners. Local surf schools offer lessons to help you catch your first wave.
- Horseback Riding: \$ Enjoy a 3.5-hour ride along seven different beaches and jungle trails, culminating at El Chorro waterfall, one of the few waterfalls worldwide that drops directly into the ocean.

Sea Turtle Conservation Experiences

ASVO Sea Turtle Hatchery: Free Located steps away from Ylang Ylang Resort, the ASVO (Asociación de Voluntarios para el Servicio en las Áreas Protegidas) Sea Turtle Hatchery offers visitors the chance to witness the release of baby turtles into the ocean, typically around 4:30 PM. This heartwarming experience allows you to see the dedicated efforts of volunteers who protect turtle eggs and ensure the hatchlings' safe journey to the sea.

- **Zip Line Canopy Tour**: \$ Experience the thrill of soaring through the jungle on nine zip-line cables totaling 1,320 meters. The tour includes a refreshing swim at the Montezuma waterfall.
- Mal Pais Canopy Tour: \$ Near the entrance of the Cabo Blanco Nature Reserve, there are eight
 zip-line cables with eleven platforms, including a suspension bridge, a Tarzan swing, and a zip-line on a
 surfboard.
- **Daily Yoga Classes**: \$ Ylang Ylang's serene studio overlooks the beach. Classes cater to all levels and are open to both guests and the public.
- **Spa Treatments**: \$ Ylang Ylang's resort spa offers a range of treatments, including massages and facials, set amidst the tranquil sounds of the jungle.
